November - Month of the Holy Souls

During the month of November, we are encouraged to pray for all the faithful departed. Our annual memorial service will take place at 7:00pm on Thursday 19th November. This event will be online only, as we cannot accommodate all the bereaved in the church. We have celebrated over 75 funerals in the past year.

Pope Francis

Pope Francis began his Wednesday General Audience noting that the event must "unfortunately" be held once again in the library of the Apostolic Palace without the presence of the faithful.

He called it a reminder of the importance of respecting the directives laid out by political and health authorities. He also invited everyone to pray for those who are ill with Covid-19 and for the medical personnel working hard to treat them. "Let us offer the Lord this distance between us, for the good of all," he said. "And let us think often about the ill, those who are already considered left behind. Let us think about doctors, nurses, volunteers, and the many people who are working with the sick right now, who risk their lives but do it out of love, their vocation, and love for their neighbour. Let us pray for them."

The Archdiocese is offering an online Diploma in Catechetics. It is aimed at lay people who are involved in the catechetical work of the Church, e.g. children's liturgists, RCIA team members, teachers, youth group leaders etc., but anyone who wants to learn more about their faith and perhaps become more involved at parish level. We would encourage as many people as possible to take part. Accompanying others is a huge part of our faith and this course will really help parishioners feel sure about what they are sharing. The cost is very reasonable – only £100. Please speak to one of the priests if you'd like to do the course, and can commit, but finance is an issue. The course will be run over a year (January - December 2021) and will be coordinated by Sr. Anna Marie McGuan and will consist of 6 modules of 6 classes each, taught in weekly 45-minute lectures (Thursday evenings at 7:30pm). Assessment will be oral, a short interview via Zoom at the end of each module. The course will be taught by a variety of religious and diocesan priests, lay people and religious sisters.

There will be an **introductory online session for anyone interested in finding out more about the Diploma on 24 November 2020** and **the course will begin officially on 12 January 2021**. Details will be published on the Archdiocese's social media and website.
