The Angelus The name is derived from the first few words of the text in Latin (Angelus Domini nuntiavit Mariae). It is a simple yet powerful prayer that offers an opportunity to meditate on Mary's discipleship and radical obedience to God's will. The prayer commemorates the Incarnation of Christ and is based on Biblical texts narrating the mystery of the Incarnation. It is normally recited three times a day: in the morning, at noon and in the evening. It is also called an Angelic Salutation, as it recalls the moment that Archangel Gabriel came to Mary with a message that would change human sitting school, college, and university dramatically opening our hearts up to exams.
