> Chrism Mass will take place in St Mary's Cathedral on Tuesday 26 March at 7pm. At this Mass we not only celebrate the Institution of the Eucharist, the Institution of the Priesthood and the blessing of the oils that will be used in all the parishes in the Archdiocese during the next twelve months, the clergy also renew the priestly promises. It is our intention to organise a coach to this Mass, so that we can join the Archbishop, clergy, religious and lay faithful throughout archdiocese praying for the needs of the clergy and archdiocese.
